SPATIAL CAPITAL OF SAUDI ARABIAN CITIES **GROUND REPORT FOR UN-HABITAT**

UN-Habitat's ongoing project "The City Prosperity Initiative" aims through data collection and analysis to better understand cities and their conditions for sustainable development. In this context Spacescape has been asked to analyze the spatial conditions in 17 Saudi Arabian cities for the report "Spatial Capital of Saudi Arabian Cities".

Land use and connectivity data were examined and an analysis model was produced in which the concept of Spatial Capital is introduced and its relation to socio-economic performance is studied. The concept of Spatial Capital refers to the affordances of cities based on their spatial configuration and is a concept previously introduced by Lars Marcus, here used for the first time by UN-Habitat.
